

Radio host Garrison Keillor to undergo medical procedure

Garrison Keillor, host of public radio's popular "A Prairie Home Companion," says he's canceling an upcoming show to undergo a medical procedure.

Keillor didn't specify the procedure but says: "I now know more about the prostate than I ever wanted to."

The 72-year-old humorist and best-selling author says the procedure is set for Sept. 25, so he's canceling a Sept. 27 show at the Fitzgerald Theater in St. Paul. But he says the season opener, street dance and meatloaf supper is still set for Sept. 20.
