

Keillor to discuss humor

Humorist Garrison Keillor, host of the radio series "A Prairie Home Companion," will talk about pioneer humor Sunday at the Hyland Lake Park Reserve Prairie Festival. The festival, which will run from 1 to 3 p.m., will focus on the culture and natural history of Minnesota when pioneers were beginning to settle the prairies. A naturalist will lead horse-drawn hayrides into the reserve's restored prairie and there will be craft and apple cider demonstrations and film and slide presentations. Activities will be held at the Richardson Nature Center at 8737 E. Bush Lake Rd., Bloomington. Admission is \$2. Parking is an additional \$2, but free for those with a Hennepin County Park Reserve permit.
