Keillor, NPR settle

WASHINGTON — Garrison Keillor and National Public Radio said Thursday they had settled a lawsuit that the star of *A Prairie Home Companion* brought alleging copyright infringement.

The terms call for NPR, through Keillor, to make available free to people who request them 400 cassettes of a disputed speech Keillor made in October, 1987, at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C. NPR, which long has transmitted National Press Club luncheon appearances, included the speech in its catalog of cassettes for sale. Keillor said he never gave NPR permission to use the speech.
