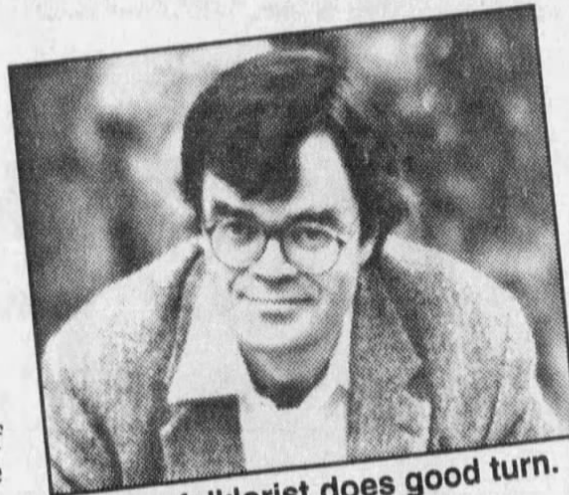


Above-average ride on Wobegon Trail
