KSJR radio to broadcast Christmas Day specials

COLLEGEVILLE — Christmas Day programming will be highlighted with some special holiday presentation over KSJR.

At 7 a.m. the complete ballet music of Tchaikovsky's "The Nutcracker" will be performed by the London Symphony with Andre Previn conducting followed by "The Music of Germany" sang by the Elizabethan Singers, the Deller Consort, the choir of the Montserrat Cloister and organist E. Power Biggs
