Garrison Keillor, known for "A Prairie Home Companion" radio show, made his Grand Ole Opry debut with help from country music greats Chet Atkins and Roy Acuff.

Keillor, who appeared Saturday in Nashville, Tenn. on Acuff's segment of the 63-year-old show, was accompanied by Atkins on guitar.

"There's a tradition of dog songs in country music, such as "Old Shep" and "Old Blue," Keillor said, "but I'll bet this is the first time a song about a cat has been sung on the Opry."
