While I must confess to having never heard his popular program that dominated the PBS Radio airways for over 13 years nor read a single word of his many publications, I did cram in over seven hours of listening to his tapes in preparation for this interview/review. I was not, therefore, too terribly disappointed when my scheduled telephone interview fell through when Keillor reportedly overstayed a luncheon appointment in Wisconsin and missed

I arrived early at Symphony Hall to chat with a few devoted fans before curtain time. Many had traveled from all areas of the county as well as parts north to be witness to this historical event. They dropped names from Keillor's fictional town of Lake Wobegon as if they were long-lost friends. They spoke of various events and special occasions that happened there as they would of relatives' birthdays or weddings.

Keillor presents himself as the town humorist and the kind of fellow one would want to visit with on a Sunday afternoon. He is joined on stage for his tour by singers Robin and Linda Williams and Kate MacKenzie, who along with the congenial host, form the Hopeful Gospel Quartet.

The stage production offers a glimpse into the nostalgic days of radio, showing us a time that electronic media seems to have forgotten.

The San Diego performance will be broadcast at noon Sunday on KPBS. For a live performance from Los Angeles, tune in 4:30 p.m. Saturday when Keillor and company will be joined by several yet-to-be announced celebrities.
