Chapman and Raitt on summer schedule

Local Tracy Chapman fans can unpack their suitcases.

They no longer have to travel to Montreal, Boston or San Francisco to catch the Grammy-winning singer/songwriter in concert; she's coming straight to them.

Chapman and her openers, sizzling hot South African rock stars Johnny Clegg and Savuka, lead the lineup for this year's Finger Lakes Performing Arts Center summer schedule, released by the Rochester Broadway Theatre League yesterday.

The center, on the campus of the Community College of the Finger Lakes in Hopewell, Ontario County, is a stone's throw from Canandaigua.

Also visiting the shell will be Grammy-darling Bonnie Raitt, Fleetwood Mac (minus former lead singer Lindsay Buckingham), the pop-rock Moody Blues and the Southern rock 'n' blues group Little Feat. Jazz/rock singer Rickie Lee Jones brings crossover country artist Lyle Lovett with her and Garrison Keillor pairs up with Chet Atkins. Pop-rockers Tears for Fears will open with Sean Penn's little brother, folksy Michael Penn.

Tickets for these shows go on sale Monday at the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra box office, 100 East Ave., the Community War Memorial box office, Broad Street and Exchange Blvd., all Ticketron outlets and through Teletron.

In addition to the following, fourteen more concerts are in the works for summer and will be announced later, said Theatre League spokeswoman Nancy Calocerinos. Unless otherwise noted, all ticket prices are \$22.50 for reserved inside seats and \$14 for lawn seats. All concerts begin at 8 p.m.
