Keillor, companions try Big D prairie

Garrison Keillor will spin his tales — verbal escapades about a mythical land with all kinds of fascinating folk — in Dallas on Saturday.

Keillor will air his nationally syndicated *American Radio Company* show live from the Bronco Bowl. The program is heard locally on KERA/90.1 FM.

Keillor honed his storytelling style on *A Prairie Home Companion*, which made him and the mythical town of Lake Wobegon, Mich., household words during its 1984-87 run.

Saturday's two-hour performance will feature Keillor's Broadway Local Theater Company and the Coffee Club Orchestra, plus local musicians the Dixie Chicks and Grammy-winning fiddler Johnny Gimble.

Keillor's show normally originates from Lamb's Theatre in New York. This will be his only Texas appearance with his variety show.

Garrison Keillor's *American Radio Company* performs at 5 p.m. Saturday at the Bronco Bowl, 2600 Fort Worth Ave., Dallas. Tickets to the show are \$21 for 90.1 members, \$26 for non-members.
