## Bank sponsors radio program

WIS. RAPIDS — First Wisconsin National Bank will sponsor a live broadcast of Garrison Keillor's radio show, "American Radio Company," from 5-7 p.m. Saturday, on radio station WHRM, 90.9 FM.

The broadcast will originate from the Historic Pabst Theater in Milwaukee and will be broadcast nationwide on public radio.

Keillor is best known as the creator and host of "A Prairie Home Companion," the live, weekly radio show broadcast from St. Paul, Minn., for 13 years.

Its successor, "American Radio Company," made its debut in November 1989, and regularly draws nearly 1½ million listeners for its weekly broadcast.

In addition to his work as a radio host, Keillor writes for the New Yorker, The Atlantic, Harper's and other magazines, and is also the author of several best-selling books including "Leaving Home," "Happy to be Here," and "Lake Wobegon Days." He has been featured on the cover of Time magazine, and has received the George Foster Peabody and Edward R. Murrow awards.
