Keillor to broadcast live from IU campus

BLOOMINGTON — Garrison Keillor's American Radio Company will make its only appearance in the tri-state area of Indiana, Kentucky and Ohio on Saturday, Feb. 22, when it will broadcast live from the Indiana University Auditorium.

Sponsored by IU's radio station WFIU, southern Indiana's only NPR radio station, the company's appearance will be an opportunity for the audience not only to witness the popular humorist in action, but a chance to observe the workings of the radio medium.

Also appearing with the American Radio Company during its two-hour, live show will be renowned guitarist Chet Atkins.

While the broadcast begins at 6 p.m., the audience must be seated by 5:45 p.m. for a "warm-up." There will be no intermissions during the live broadcast.

The early hour of this event will provide an excellent opportunity for those attending to travel to Bloomington, enjoy the production and begin the trip home shortly after 8 p.m., the hour when most entertainment events on the campus are just beginning.
