

Garrison Keillor sets Claremont show

Garrison Keillor will bring his "American Radio Company" to Bridges Auditorium of The Claremont Colleges for a live radio broadcast on Saturday, April 4 at 3 p.m.

Country music star Roger Miller will be Keillor's guest for this one-time performance.

Keillor began his radio career at Minnesota Public Radio in 1968. In 1974, while writing an article on the Grand Ole Opry for the "New Yorker," he was struck by the notion of creating a live variety show for radio. "A Prairie Home Companion" was born.

Keillor is a regular contributor to the "New Yorker" and a best-selling author.
