People were standing in line recently for tickets to Garrison Keillor's June 11 "A Prairie Home Companion" show, which will be broadcast from the Kiva Auditorium at the Albuquerque Convention Center. To date, an estimated 700 tickets have been sold, including 12 in the \$125 category, said Sharon Rogers, development director of KANW-FM. The performance is a benefit for the public radio station, which faces being cut from Albuquerque Public Schools' budget. The performance will be broadcast live on KANW and will be transmitted to hundreds of stations nationwide. Tickets are available at the station and at Ticketmaster outlets. The \$125 ticket includes a VIP reception with Keillor after the show.
