Joe was one of six campers selected to perform from the theatre arts major divisions. A senior at Charlotte High School, Joe is the son of Kirk and Mary Evans of Charlotte. For the show, Joe played a teenager out to steal Keillor's daughter away in one of three skits presented.

The radio program combines music, theatrical skits and stories, plus commentary from Keillor's fictional Midwestern town, Lake Wobegon. For this program, Joe performed before 4,000 people at Kresge Auditorium and had another 2 million listening at home.
