Garrison Keillor, the shy guy from Minnesota, brings a little bit of Lake Wobegon to Sioux Falls on May 9 when he flies in for breakfast at Augustana College's Elmen Center.

Keillor decided to barnstorm cities with Minnesota Public Radio stations, says Ronelle Thompson, Augustana library director. Sioux Falls is one of those.

"It was his idea to do this," she says. She doesn't know why Keillor planned the trip, but the breakfast will be co-hosted by the Augustana College Library Associates and KRSD-FM, the local Minnesota Public Radio affiliate.
