

## Keillor, NMSO team up

Author, humorist and radio legend Garrison Keillor will perform March 18 with the New Mexico Symphony Orchestra in Popejoy Hall, the NMSO has announced.

Keillor and the NMSO will present a program that will include monologues, some of Keillor's famous routines and more, all musically accompanied by the orchestra.

Famous for his tales of the fictional Lake Wobegon, Keillor is the founder and host of "A Prairie Home Companion" heard Saturday evenings on public radio. He is heard by more than 4 million listeners each week over 558 stations, including KANW in Albuquerque, KRWG in Las Cruces, KENW in Portales and KGLP in Gallup.

Keillor has performed with many orchestras, including the Minnesota Symphony Orchestra, the Los Angeles Philharmonic and the Chicago, Milwaukee, San Francisco, Pittsburgh, Dallas and National symphonies.

He also is the author of numerous books, including "Lake Wobegon Days," "The Book of Guys," "Love Me" and "Lake Wobegon Summer 1956."
