

Garrison Keillor will spin his tales from Portland stage

The host of "A Prairie Home Companion" radio show, Garrison Keillor, will play two shows at Schnitzer Hall in Portland this weekend.

The Minnesotan's program has been getting more attention this year after the release of a movie based on the show and with the same name.

Keillor will sing and perform his Lake Wobegon monologues, making for an evening of both music and humor. Philip Brunelle will conduct.

The performances are Friday and Saturday at 7:30 p.m. The hall is at 1037 SW Broadway in Portland.
