

'Prairie Home' show sells out

Tickets for the local appearances of "Prairie Home Companion" sold out quickly yesterday, the first day of sale.

The popular National Public Radio show will broadcast live from the Warfield Theatre at 3 p.m. May 4. Tickets were also sold for a preview performance at the 2,200-seat theater May 3. Prices were \$15-\$18 for the broadcast, \$12.50-\$15 for the preview.

The offbeat show, hosted by Garrison Keillor and set in the mythical Minnesota town of Lake Woebegeon, regularly broadcasts from St. Paul, Minn. It is carried locally on KALW and KQED-FM. The KQED broadcast is sponsored by The Examiner.
