

Noted humorist to appear in San Antonio Garrison Keillor opens symphony season

SAN ANTONIO — Each Saturday night for more than 17 years, 240 American Public Radio stations have brought the news from Lake Wobegon, Minnesota, into homes across the U.S. This Sept. 17, 18, and 19, Lake Wobegon comes to South Texas, as humorist and best-

selling author Garrison Keillor opens the San Antonio POPS season. Shows Friday and Saturday, Sept. 17-18 will be at 8 p.m., Sunday's show, Sept. 19 is a 2 p.m. matinee.

Garrison Keillor created the fictional town of Lake Wobegon in 1974, when he brought A

Prairie Home Companion to American Public Radio. The music and variety format of the Companion took listeners into Keillor's beloved Midwest, and to the typically rural town Lake Wobegon. "Where all the women are strong, all the men are good looking, and all the children are

above average."
