

# 'A Prairie Home Companion' comes to Salt Lake

Garrison Keillor will bring his humor, music and the romance of live radio to Salt Lake City on Saturday, June 10 when "A Prairie Home Companion" will be broadcast live at 5 p.m. from Abravanel Hall, 123 W. South Temple. The two-hour broadcast will feature all regular favorites including the Cafe Boeuf comedy sketch, music performed by Guy's All Star Shoe Band and Garrison Keillor's signature monologue — The News From Lake Wobegon.

The Mormon Tabernacle Choir, one of America's oldest and best-loved musical institutions, will be featured music guests on the

program. The choir, more than 300 voices strong, has released 150 albums of choral masterworks, religious, Christmas, folk and patriotic music on the Columbia and London-Delca labels.

The program will be broadcast over 295 public radio stations to two million people nationwide. Tickets are \$17 to \$40 and go on sale Monday, April 17 at all ArtTix outlets and the Capitol Theatre or call (801) 355-ARTS.

The public should be at Abravanel Hall by 3:45 p.m. for seating.
