## Keillor to host holiday special

hosts a new program celebrating the Thanksgiving holiday, "Over the River and Through the Woods," which will be broadcast on Yellowstone Public Radio Thanksgiving Day, Nov. 27, at 11 a.m.

Produced by Minnesota Public Radio, "Over the River and Through the Woods" teams up Keillor, host of "A Prairie Home Companion," with Philip Brunelle and the Ensemble Singers of the Plymouth Music Series of Minnesota; they have created an enchanting exploration of the American Thanksgiving experience.

The show is a delightful blend of poetry and American song. Host Keillor reads poems appropriate to the holiday in his own inimitable style, alternating with the Ensemble's choral selections. The presentation was recorded live at Bethel College in St. Paul.

Keillor is host of both "A Prairie Home Companion" and "The Writers Almanac," produced by Minnesota Public Radio. He has made a number of recordings with Brunelle and the Plymouth Music Series, including "Song of the Cat," "Lake Wobegon Revisited," and "The Young Lutheran's Guide to the Orchestra."

Brunelle founded the Ensemble Singers in 1991 as the professional core of the Plymouth Music Series

Each year they perform on Public Radio International's "Welcome Christmas," and were the first professional American chorus to sing at the Prague Spring Festival last June.
